**Please read all these notes carefully before completing your application form. Failure to complete the application form correctly will result in your application being delayed. The committee has the right to refuse applications for Associate Junior Membership. Associate Junior Membership Cards will be valid from the date of issue until 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018 inclusive.**

Note 1 Personal information you provide will be held on the SDAA Ltd members register computer database and will not be passed on to any other organisation. If you provide phone numbers and/or an email address it will be assumed that you have no objection to these being used by the club to contact you.

Note 2 If the member has already purchased a Membership Book, the current membership book number **must** be inserted, which is printed in the top right hand corner of the page containing your name and address. If applying for both an Associate Junior Membership Card and your own Membership Book leave this blank, but you must include a separate application form for your own membership.

Note 3 Please state the member's relationship to the child applying for Associate Junior Membership.

Note 4 The upper age for Associate Junior Membership is in line with the EA Junior rod licence, i.e. an EA Junior rod licence is required for persons who have reached the age of 12 but have not reached the age of 17).

Note 5 Associate Junior Membership is free, but subject to the following additional rules:

- Associate Junior Membership Cards must be carried at all times whilst on club waters.
- Associate Junior Members can only fish whilst accompanied by the member shown overleaf.
- Members and their Associate Junior Members must occupy a single swim.
- Associate Junior Members can only fish with one rod.
- Associate Junior Members cannot fish IPA waters.
- Associate Junior Members are not permitted to vote at the AGM.
- Associate Junior Members can claim specimen trophies.

If the junior wishes to fish their own swim or with two rods, they must first purchase a full Junior Membership Book. Full Junior Members aged 12 and over can also fish unaccompanied (with parental consent), except whilst night fishing.

Note 6 Associate Junior Membership And Night Fishing

- The SDAA committee has decided to make a concession on night fishing for Associate Junior Members. This is being run as a trial, which may be modified or withdrawn without notice.
- The adult member named on the Associate Junior membership card can apply for permission to take the Associate Junior Member with them whilst night fishing The Airman, Broom Lake or Willington Lake for free. If the adult member is not the parent/guardian it is their responsibility to ensure the parent/guardian has given approval for the application. - Applications need to be made several days in advance quoting the name and membership number of the adult member as well as the name and number of the Associate Junior Member. The venue and dates of the intended trip must also be given. The adult member must be in possession of the appropriate adult night permit.
- The Registrar will decide whether or not to grant permission and will send a letter or email informing the adult member of the decision. The Registrar will usually grant permission for each Associate Junior Member up to a maximum of three nights during the season. The permission letter or email must be shown to a bailiff on request.
- If the associate junior wants to accompany the adult member on a more regular basis whilst night fishing, then the adult should apply for a Non-Fishing Night Guest Permit (cost £25).
- Adult members are limited to being accompanied by a single Associate Junior whilst night fishing and are responsible for their actions at all times. This initiative is designed to allow Associate Juniors to sample the experience of night fishing at no charge. The adult member must judge whether the Associate Junior is capable of actively fishing at night or whether to just enjoy the 'camping' experience.

Note 7 The form must be signed by a parent/guardian. If the parent/guardian is not the member who will accompany the child, they must also provide their contact details.
