Please read all these notes carefully before completing your application form. Failure to complete the application form correctly or not provide the correct paperwork will result in your application being delayed. The committee has the right to refuse applications for Membership, Night Permits and Non-Fishing Night Guest Permits. Half year membership books are only valid for fishing from 1st December 2019. Membership and Night Permits will be valid until 15th June 2020 inclusive.

- Note 1 Personal information you provide will be held on the SDAA Ltd members register computer database and will not be passed on to any other organisation. If you provide phone numbers and/or an email address it will be assumed that you have no objection to these being used by the club to contact you. Fields marked with an asterisk (*) must be completed or your application will not be processed.
- Note 2 To apply for Partner Membership you **must** be the cohabiting partner of a member. You must insert the membership book number of your partner, which is printed in the top right hand corner of the page containing their name and address. If both partners are applying at the same time, this can be left blank.
- Note 3 Optional Night Permits are required to night fish at The Airman, Broom Lake and Willington Lake. Two separate Night Permits are available for The Airman or Broom Lake. Either Night Permit allows the member to night fish at Willington Lake. A single Night Permit for Adult, Concessionary and Partner members will cost £53 a season, and a second Night Permit will cost £26.50 a season. Please make sure you clearly indicate the venue where you want your first Night Permit to be valid. Each Night Permit application **must** be accompanied by two recent passport size photos, i.e. 4 photos if applying for both (please print your name on the reverse).
- Note 4 If you already have a Night Permit and you are applying only for a second Night Permit please insert the number of your first Night Permit. Please remember to include two recent passport size photos for each Night Permit.
- Note 5 The upper age for Junior Membership is in line with the EA Junior rod licence (i.e. an EA Junior rod licence is required for persons who have reached the age of 12 but have not reached the age of 17). Alternatively children under the age of 17 years can apply for **free** Associate Junior Membership via the Registrar. Associate Junior Members can only fish with a single rod when supervised by a member aged 18 or over in the same swim. Associate Junior Members cannot fish IPA waters or vote at the AGM.
- Note 6 Junior Night Permit are required by junior members to night fish at The Airman, Broom Lake and Willington Lake. A single Junior Night Permit covers all three waters. Junior Night Permit holders must be accompanied by a Night Permit holder aged 18 or over (authorised by a parent/guardian) and occupy the same swim whilst night fishing at The Airman and Broom Lake, or adjacent swims at Willington Lake. Junior Night Permits applications **must** be accompanied by two recent passport size photos (please print your name on the reverse).
- Note 7 Night Permit holders (but not juniors) can be accompanied by a **single** non-fishing guest whilst night fishing The Airman, Broom Lake and Willington Lake, provided they obtain a Non-Fishing Night Guest Permit in advance, which cost £26.50 a season. Applications for a Non-Fishing Night Guest Permit **must** include two recent passport sized photos of the non-fishing guest (please print your non-fishing guest's name on the reverse). Night Permit holders must accompany their non-fishing guests at all times and will be held responsible for their actions. Please note that guests are not members of the club and therefore guests are not covered by the club's insurance. Night Permit holders are only allowed a single non-fishing guest at any time whilst night fishing, but a Night Permit holder may purchase more than one Non-Fishing Night Guest Permit each season.
- Note 8 Keys are required to open gates at The Airman, Broom Lake, Willington, the parking area near Jordans Mill and the allotments at Little Paxton. Keys from last season (A10) will still fit locks after 15th June 2019.
- Note 9 If you have already purchased your membership book and are only applying for a Night Permit and/or Non-Fishing Night Guest Permit you **must** insert your current membership book number, which is printed in the top right hand corner of the page containing your name and address. If applying for both a Night Permit and membership book leave this blank.
- Note 10 Please note that if any cheques are returned, the club incurs additional costs. **We will charge you an additional £15 if a cheque is not honoured by your bank.** Only cheques or postal orders will be accepted, do not send cash.
- Note 11 If you are happy to do so, we will accept electronic transfers (please email info@shefforddaa.org.uk for details of the SDAA Ltd account to use). However, we will not accept any liability if you accidentally send the money to an incorrect account. You must remember to include your surname in the reference section for the transfer as we will need to check that the money is in the SDAA Ltd account before sending you your documents.
- Note 12 Please make sure that you enclose the correct size of envelope and postage, otherwise the Post Office will charge you the unpaid postage plus an 'administration fee' before they will deliver the item. If applying for a membership book, the SAE must have a minimum envelope size of C5 (162x229mm) and a 'large letter' stamp as the thickness will exceed 5mm. If you are only applying for a night permit and/or Non-Fishing Night Guest Permit a standard 'DL' sized (110x220mm) envelope and 'letter' postage will suffice.
